Camp Hours

Day camp day starts at 8:00 am and ends at 5:30 pm with an option for parents to register for extended care (6:30 am-8:00 am & 5:30 pm-6:00 pm) for an additional fee.

Fees: Traditional Day Camp (Grades 1-8)

YMCA Members \$135/Week- \$160 with extended care
Non Members \$175/Week- \$215 with extended care

Sunrise Camp (ages 3-Kindergarten)

Full-Day: YMCA Members \$160/Non Members \$162.50
